**RE: FAMILY AND CHILDREN (FAC) MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
 TRICKLE/SPROUT CHANGES**

PROGRAMS AFFECTED: MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

SUMMARY:

The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) identified a change in the Family and Children (FAC) medical assistance trickling and sprouting process. Effective August 25, 2008, CARES will be modified as follows:

- F01 will sprout to an F05 coverage group.
- If not eligible for F05 coverage, CARES will automatically trickle and test a case for the following coverage groups in the order listed:
 - F02 – only eligible if overscale due to earnings and customer was active in F01 and/or F05 coverage groups for 3 out of the last 6 months.
 - F03 – only eligible if overscale due to child or spousal support and customer was active in F01 and/or F05 coverage groups for 3 out of the last 6 months.
 - F98 – case will go straight into F99 spenddown unless found overscale assets (denied or closed with primary reason code 401).
 - F99 – spenddown case will be created.
- Medical Coverage Group F04 has been discontinued.
- P-track AUs will continue to sprout as they did prior to July 1.

A flow chart of the new FAC trickle/sprout process is attached.
