

Living at Home Waiver Program

Providing community services and supports to enable people with physical disabilities to live in their own home.

What is an Environmental Accessibility Adaptation Service?

Environmental Accessibility Adaptation Services – a physical adaptations or modifications to a participant’s home or place of residence required to make the participant’s home physically accessible.

Types of Environmental Accessibility Adaptation Providers

There is one type of Environmental Accessibility Adaptation Provider.

Agency – Employed Model – provider must be a store, vendor, contractor, or builder from which the adaptation is purchased.

Credentials for Agency Employed Environmental Accessibility Adaptation Providers

Evidence that the applicant is a store, vendor, contractor, or builder which either sells (and is able to provide or arrange for required installation, servicing, and maintenance) or is qualified to construct the home modifications covered under the waiver.

If the provider performs construction:

- A. Copy of license(s) as a contractor or builder and
- B. Evidence the provider is properly bonded.

Payment Rate Effective July 1, 2006

\$6,124.18 total amount of reimbursement by the Program for environmental accessibility adaptations and assistive technology combined during a 12 month period.
