

## ***Living at Home Waiver Program***

Providing community services and supports to enable people with physical disabilities to live in their own home.

### **What is Nurse Supervision Services?**

**Nurse Supervision Services** – Develops specific plan for attendant care, provides specific, health related information and training to the attendant(s) concerning topics related to the nursing care of the enrolled participant, as necessary; conducts one on one visits in the enrolled participant's home or another community-based setting where attendant care services are received.

### **Types of Nurse Supervision Service Providers**

There are two types of Nurse Supervision Service Providers: Consumer – Employed Model and Agency – Employed Model.

Consumer Employed Model – a self employed, Medicaid provider to render services.

Agency Employed Model – an agency is the Medicaid provider which employs registered nurses or nurse practitioners.

### **Credentials for Consumer Employed Nurse Supervision Service Providers**

#### Consumer – Employed Model

- A. Copy of current license as a registered nurse or nurse practitioner and
- B. Copy of current resume demonstrating experience providing nursing services to adults with physical disabilities.

### **Payment Rate Effective July 1, 2006**

\$26.17 per hour

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### **Credentials for Agency Employed Nurse Supervision Service Providers**

#### Agency – Employed Model

1. Agency license or documentation of provider status.
  - A. Home Health Agency current license, or
  - B. Residential Services Agency current license, or
  - C. Local Health Department – Medical Assistance Personal Care Program (MAPCP), or
  - D. Copy of approval by the Medicaid Program as an agency provider of personal care services or nurse case monitoring, or
  - E. Identification as In- Home Aid Service Program at a local department of social services, or
  - F. Copy of approval as a vendor agency for the Department of Human Resources In-Home Aide Program
  
2. List of all nurse's name and social security numbers
  - A. Copy of current license as registered nurse or nurse practitioner and
  - B. Copy of current resume demonstrating experience providing nursing services to adults with physical disabilities.

### **Payment Rate Effective July 1, 2006**
